Preparing to Provide the Discharge Medicines Service ACTION REQUIRED BY ALL CONTRACTORS

The Discharge Medicines Service (DMS) is a new **Essential Service** which all pharmacies must provide from **Monday 15th February 2021.** From this date, NHS Trusts will be able to digitally refer patients for provision of the DMS at their community pharmacy and contractors will be able to submit claims for payment for their activity.

Please see our <u>service summary</u> which includes information on funding, how referrals will be made and actions you need to take to prepare for the service.

Remember, the DMS builds on the work that has been undertaken as part of the Transfer of Care Around Medicines (TCAM) programme, referred to locally as Connect with Pharmacy. We are in a fantastic position in West Yorkshire as all our Hospital Trusts are live with Connect with Pharmacy and are therefore already enabled to send electronic referrals to community pharmacies via PharmOutcomes.

From the 15th February 2021, Connect with Pharmacy will effectively change to reflect the requirements of the DMS and referrals must be actioned as described in the NHSE&I guidance on the regulations, see chapter 8 – page 20.

Please act now. Contractors need to be ready to deliver this service from next week.
