

Pharmacy Quality Scheme 2023/24: Bulletin 8 - Gateway Criteria, Medicines Safety & Optimisation Domain and Prevention Domain

PQS Gateway Criteria: New Medicines Service (NMS) - DEADLINE 31st DECEMBER

To make a claim for PQS payments, pharmacies must first meet the Gateway Criteria of completing 15 or more New Medicines Service (NMS) between 1st April 2023 and by 31st December 2023. Check how many NMS you have completed so far and make a plan to reach the required number, by the end of December!

Medicines Safety & Optimisation – High Risk Medicines – Anticoagulant Audit

Reminder – Pharmacies will need to evidence their implementing into day-to-day practice, the recommendations for community pharmacy from the first Anticoagulant Audit from the PQS 2021/22. Visit the CPWY Pharmacy Quality Scheme webpage here to see a summarry of the report recommendations.
