



# **Medicines Safety Information**

It has been brought to our attention that there are individuals trying to obtain large quantities of Methocarbamol through community pharmacies. This is occurring across West Yorkshire and the Greater Manchester Area. It isn't yet fully clear how all these supplies have been accessed, however we are asking all teams to be aware, it is a drug which is proving in demand and to take necessary precautions and check NCRS for emergency supplies that are being requested. Please speak to GP's where possible if you have concerns. We are still receiving lots of queries and requests for information about training so please see below a summary of training that is available to access below  $\psi$ .

#### **Claiming Payment**

All pharmacies providing the service should have access to the Pharmacy First IT module within their chosen clinical service IT system to allow the necessary clinical records for the service to be recorded. As per the previous Community Pharmacist Consultation Service (CPCS), consultations recorded will automatically populate a claim for payment within the NHSBSA's MYS portal, however, this will not automatically submit the claim for payment. Contractors will need to login to MYS to check that the data matches the details in their IT system and then submit the claim for payment.


Don't forget there are a range of online resources, face to face practical workshops and other training offers available to support clinical skills and knowledge development:

#### **COVID-19 Vaccination Service**

NHSE has written to pharmacies currently providing the COVID-19 Vaccination Service to ask whether they would be willing to extend the duration of their current contract to provide the service until 31st August 2024. This extension is being considered in anticipation of a potential Spring booster programme, pending guidance from the Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation (JCVI).

Pharmacies that are contracted to provide the COVID-19 Vaccination Service have been asked to inform their local commissioner by **22nd February 2024**, if they can continue offering the service. Read more here.

## Pharmacy Contraception Service (PCS)

Just a reminder that those pharmacies that signed up to provide the Pharmacy Contraception Service **before** 1st December 2023, (Tier 1; repeat supply of oral contraception), will need to "opt-in" to provide the extended PCS (i.e. initiation and repeat supply) by **29**<sup>th</sup> **February 2024.** Any pharmacies providing the Tier 1 service who do not opt-in by that date will be automatically deregistered from the service (and they will be informed of this by the NHSBSA).

## **Discharge Medicines Service (DMS)**

Please see the February edition of the DMS newsletter, (<u>see here</u>), which is produced by the ICB for community pharmacy teams. This includes a reminder that DMS is not just for patients on Monitored Dosage Systems/Compliance Aids/ Dosette Boxes. **ANY** patient requiring support with their medicines on discharge may be referred for a DMS.

# Registration for Foundation (Pre-registration) Pharmacists Training – Do Not Miss the Recruitment Deadline

Pharmacist training is changing significantly to meet the new standards published by the GPhC – incorporating prescribing at the point of registration. Moving forward, you will not be able to provide foundation training without recruiting via the NHSE Oriel system. Training sites MUST be entered into Oriel/NRS between 11th January 2024 – 1st March 2024.

See more information <u>here</u>. You must agree to terms of participation, and that you will provide access to DPP and prescribing learning environment. Please note at this point in time:

- You do not need to identify who the DPP is and where the prescribing environment is.
- If a multi-sector rotation is being included, you must identify where this rotational site is.

All training sites wishing to provide training for Foundation Trainee Pharmacists (formerly Preregistration Trainee Pharmacists), will need to be included on the <u>Oriel platform</u>. This comes into effect for the 2025/26 training year – but the deadline for entering your programmes into Oriel is 1st March 2024.

## New Podcast Series: 'Surviving Crisis: Learning from Lived Experience'

A new podcast series which has been launched this week aims to support staff working with people in mental health crisis across West Yorkshire. The five-episode series, called 'Surviving Crisis: Learning from Lived Experience' has been created by volunteers on West Yorkshire Health and Care Partnership's <u>Suicide Prevention Coproduction Project</u>, who all have experience of suicidal crisis. The series uses insights from frontline health and care staff who were asked in advance to share their thoughts on what they would like discussed.

Episode one discusses questions staff might want to ask a person with experience of suicidal ideation that they feel they can't ask in everyday work. The remaining episodes will be promoted in the weeks following the launch.
