National Booking System for NHS Flu Vaccinations

Flu vaccinations for pregnant women can commence from 1st September 2025 and for all other eligible adult cohorts, from 1st October 2025.

The National Booking System (NBS) will be opened for pharmacies to post vaccination appointments from 18th August 2025 (open for bookings from the public from 1st September 2025 for vaccination from 1st October 2025). Pharmacies providing flu vaccinations can also use the NBS (e.g. you don't have to provide the COVID-19 vaccination service to be able to use it). If you would like to take up the offer to use NBS (and don't already have access to it as part of the COVID-19 vaccination service) please complete the NHSE England NBS flu form.

Choose Your IT Supplier for Covid & Flu Vaccination Services

There will not be a regionally commissioned Point of Care (PoC) IT platform to record flu or COVID-19 vaccinations for this winter's campaign. Pharmacy owners must select an NHS England-assured IT supplier and contact them directly for advice or to set up new accounts before the start of the upcoming season. Only Order What You Need' Campaign

A behaviour change campaign has been launched across West Yorkshire focusing on medicine waste (over ordering and stockpiling of medicines).

The 'Only order what you need' campaign is aimed at the public and is centred around educating patients or those ordering prescriptions on their behalf such as carers, on the impact of over-ordering and stockpiling prescription medicines, encouraging self-reflection of their ordering behaviour and to encourage patients to inform healthcare teams if receiving unintentional oversupply.
