Childhood Flu Vaccination Advanced Service

Annual Flu Letter Updated - The <u>annual flu letter</u> has recently been updated (28th July 2025) to reflect the national community pharmacy pilot that has been commissioned this year to help support improvements in access and uptake of flu vaccinations in 2-3 year olds.

The Children's Flu Vaccination Advanced Service is intended to supplement the existing general practice offer which commences on 1st September. The community pharmacy service will begin on 1st October 2025 for pharmacies registered to provide the service. The service covers all children aged 2 and 3 years of age on 31st August 2025 i.e. children who were born on or after 1st September 2021 and on or before 31st August 2023. All children aged less than 2 years of age or aged four years or over on 31st August 2025 are not covered by the service.

CPE Webinar – Book Your Place Now – CPE will be holding a webinar about the new service on Wednesday 20th August at 7.30pm. Bookings will close at midday on the day of the event, so please book to secure your place as soon as possible <u>here</u>.

Contractors who wish to provide the service are required to notify NHSE of their intention by completing an electronic declaration through the MYS portal by 31st August 2025 (to ensure they receive vaccines in time for the start of the service on 1st October). Later registration will be possible, but the provision of the centrally procured vaccine will be received after the starting date for the service. Learn more about the new service here.

Reminder: NHS Flu Vaccination Service: National Booking Service (NBS)

If you are providing the NHS Flu Vaccination Service and have never used the NBS, why not consider using it for this season's campaign. Last season (2024), nearly five million seasonal vaccination bookings were made on the NBS! Community pharmacies not already registered can apply to join the NBS by completing the Flu CP NBS Onboarding Form here with your pharmacy ODS code and contact details of two users.

You must apply **before Monday (11th August 2025)** to ensure you receive login details before 18th August, the day the NBS opens for pharmacies to post vaccination appointments. Registrations will remain open until 9th March 2026, but later applicants will need to wait up to 10 working days to receive login details.

Hypertension Case-Finding Service (HCFS) – Focus on ABPMs

Ambulatory blood pressure monitoring (ABPM) is the clinically preferred method for diagnosing hypertension. If your pharmacy provides the HCFS, it is a requirement that where a patient's reading indicates the need for ABPM, that this is offered in a timely manner. All pharmacies providing the HCFS must have an ABPM device and trained staff to deliver this element of the service.

To help you deliver the ABPM element of the HCFS, we have produced a short briefing for pharmacy teams which includes examples of how to have conversations about the service with patients. Please read our briefing here.

IMPORTANT REMINDER: ABPM Requirements from 1st October 2025 – As part of "bundling" requirements to qualify for the fixed Pharmacy First monthly payment, pharmacies will be required to deliver at least one ABPM provision per month from 1st October 2025.

Digital Gateway for Pharmacy First

Digital Gateway is a patient self-triage feature integrated within PharmOutcomes. It allows walk-in patients to scan a QR code and complete a pre-screening assessment to determine their eligibility for a Pharmacy First clinical pathway ahead of their consultation with a pharmacist.

Branded Generic Prescribing

After months of collaboration, feedback, and constructive challenge on the issue of branded generics, we are pleased to see that the Leeds QIPP plan for this year does **not** include switches to branded generics. Indeed, Leeds has issued a statement strongly supporting generic prescribing — see here.

This is a great outcome and reflects the ongoing efforts by CPWY to raise awareness of the negative impact branded generics can have on patient safety and the long-term sustainability of local pharmacy services. We will share the Leeds message with all other Places in the ICB and strive for a consistent message across West Yorkshire.

Upcoming Changes to the MYS Portal

The Manage Your Service (MYS) pharmacy portal will soon be getting a refresh to improve user experience. The update will introduce enhancements designed to streamline navigation and improve usability, such as refreshed layouts and a new status banner. The new-look portal is due to launch on Thursday 21st August 2025, with MYS temporarily unavailable between 7am to 8.30am while the changes are being made. See more information here.
