

Suggested List of Conditions for TPP In-workflow Referrals

Note: The conditions follow the order on the [Aide Memoire](#) which most practices already use to help them identify suitable conditions to be referred to the pharmacy.

Conditions

1. Bites/stings
2. Colds
3. Congestion (including sinusitis if 12+ years)
4. Ear problem
5. Eye problem
6. Gastric/bowel problem
7. Genito-urinary problem (including Uncomplicated UTI in women aged 16-64 unless pregnant or diabetic)
8. Mouth/throat
9. Pain
10. Skin (including impetigo (1 year+) or shingles (18 years + and not pregnant or rash on head or neck))
11. Swelling

Narrative

1. Bites/stings: Bee/wasp sting
2. Bites/stings: Insect bite
3. Colds: Coughs/flu-like symptoms
4. Colds: Cold Sores
5. Colds: Sore Throat
6. Congestion: Blocked or runny nose/sinusitis
7. Congestion: Hay fever
8. Ear: Earache/discharge
9. Ear: Ear wax
10. Eye: Blocked ear/hearing problems
11. Eye: Watery/runny eye
12. Eye: Sticky eye/conjunctivitis
13. Gastric: Heartburn or indigestion
14. Gastric: Infant colic
15. Gastric: Nausea or vomiting
16. Gastric: Constipation, rectal pain or haemorrhoids
17. Gastric: Diarrhoea
18. Genito-urinary: Vaginal discharge, vaginal itch or soreness
19. Genito-urinary: Cystitis or uncomplicated UTI in women
20. Mouth: Cold sores
21. Mouth: Hoarseness
22. Mouth: Sore throat
23. Mouth: Sore mouth/ulcers

24. Mouth: Oral thrush
25. Mouth: Teething or toothache
26. Other
27. Pain: Acute pain on body
28. Pain: Headache/migraine
29. Pain: Sprains or strains
30. Pain: Rectal pain
31. Skin: Acne, spots and pimples
32. Skin: Athlete's foot
33. Skin: Blisters
34. Skin: Dermatitis or eczema
35. Skin: Hair loss
36. Skin: Impetigo
37. Skin: Rash- fungal or nappy
38. Skin: Scabies
39. Skin: Shingles (18+ years, not pregnant, not on head and neck)
40. Skin: Wart/verruca
41. Skin: Wound problems
42. Swelling: Ankle or foot swelling
43. Swelling: Lower limb swelling
44. Swelling: Thigh or buttock swelling
45. Swelling: Wrist, hand, finger or toe swelling
