

Reminder – CPAF Screening Questionnaire Closes Tomorrow!

We would like to give a final reminder to pharmacy owners that if you haven't yet completed the CPAF screening questionnaire, please make sure you do so before 11.59pm tomorrow night (Friday 31st July). **Completion is a Terms of Service requirement.** Complete the questionnaire on the NHSBSA Manage Your Service (MYS) portal [here](#).

Services Information

MenB Vaccination Service Updates

Confirming eligibility – a reminder that pupils that have just completed school Year 13 are eligible for MenB vaccines based on their date of birth (born between 1st September 2007 and 31st August 2008), regardless of any future further education plans. See the [UKHSA eligibility flowchart](#) which can be used to help patients and staff assess eligibility for vaccination.

Pre-consultation screening questionnaire – CPE has developed a questionnaire for use with patients to collect some key information prior to the consultation, should pharmacy teams wish to use it – see [here](#).

 **Month-end reminder: submit your vaccination claims** – claims must be submitted within one month, and no later than three months after, vaccinations are administered. As there's currently no API linking the Record a Vaccination Service (RAVS) platform with the MYS platform, you'll need to manually transfer vaccination details into MYS to claim payment. To make the process easier, you can generate a report from RAVS to support your month-end claims. See <https://guide.ravs.england.nhs.uk/reporting/> or you can watch this short video [here](#).

Help spread the word – pharmacy teams can help increase awareness by promoting the service locally. With schools reopening for **A-level Results Day on Thursday 13th August 2026**, this could be an ideal opportunity to reach eligible students. Keep your appointment availability up to date – to help patients book appointments when vaccine stock is available, make sure your vaccination capacity and National Booking Service (NBS) appointments align with your vaccine orders and scheduled delivery dates. To keep your service running smoothly, pharmacies are advised to:

- *Review their vaccine allocation on the FDP. An allocation must be available before an order can be placed.*
- *Place an order on FDP before the order cut-off deadline having reviewed their bookings on NBS.*
- *Confirm their assigned delivery day and check for the expected delivery time which will be available one working day before the assigned delivery day. A trained member of the pharmacy team must be available between 8:00am and 5:00pm on the delivery day to receive the vaccine, as deliveries may arrive outside the estimated time window.*
- *Ensure that NBS booked appointments are scheduled for dates after the confirmed vaccine delivery. Review available appointments against the expected delivery date and plan bookings accordingly to ensure vaccine supply.*

Seasonal Vaccination Services (COVID-19 and Adult Flu) – Final Reminder

The **registration deadline is midnight tomorrow** for pharmacies wishing to provide the Autumn/Winter 2026 COVID and Adult Flu Vaccination Services and receive COVID vaccine supplies in time for the start of the campaign. Pharmacies that register after this deadline are not guaranteed to receive COVID vaccine supplies in time for the service commencement.

If you previously registered to provide COVID vaccinations for the Spring 2026 Campaign, you will automatically be registered for the Autumn/Winter Campaign (unless you have since deregistered).

Children's Flu Service

Pharmacies wishing to provide the 2026/27 Children's Flu Vaccination Service must register via the MYS portal by **midnight on 31st August 2026** to receive vaccine supplies ahead of the service launch on 1st October 2026.

The service specification for the 2026/27 service was recently published and is available [here](#). Before registering, pharmacies should ensure they have read the specification in full and are confident they can meet all of NHS England's minimum service requirements.

The cohorts eligible for vaccination under this service have been expanded to include opportunistic vaccination of two additional groups for this season and pharmacies will be able to vaccinate:

- *Children aged 2 to 3 years old.*
- *Children aged 2 years to 17 years in a clinical at risk group.*
- *From 1st December 2026 – catch up vaccinations of school aged children, from reception to year 11.*

It also aims to strengthen local supervision infrastructure by supporting the development of sustainable Designated Prescribing Practitioner (DPP) capacity across systems.

Successful bidders can expect to be notified from the week commencing 14th September 2026, subject to NHS England business case approval.
